Most people new to tarot need to learn the basics of tarot reading that does not bamboozle them with misinformation about the origin and significance of the cards. One can learn to read tarot as an exercise in creative imagination and discover the fundamentals of tarot history and symbolism in this workshop. Paul introduces a variety of simple new ways to engage in creatively learning how to read and understand tarot cards.

As any well-seasoned tarot-deck collector knows, tarot card meanings work on many levels that cannot be anticipated in simple word lists. From the first, new readers should become aware of open-ended, playful ways of tarot reading and workings. This workshop is designed to provide basic knowledge of tarot tradition with practical insight into the reflexive nature of tarot card meanings through a series of imaginative, entertaining and easy group exercises.

- Discover effective ways to become skilled at tarot reading as soon as you open your first tarot package without reading the Little White Book! Or relying on any tarot primers!
- Learn how to see and identify each card; understand the basic structure of a deck and a little tarot history and legend.
- Become aware of how tarot works in many situations, some not often considered in tarot readings
- Realize how to engage the images and symbols of tarot to enhance your basic human insights and intuitions, using tarot to aid in problem-solving.
- Gain awareness of how teamwork in readings accelerates individual learning process by making it fun and social
- Appreciate the art of tarots as a creative goad to impel many levels of serendipity and wisdom
